

Writing on Pumpkins



PEN CHOICE

We prefer to use paint pens or oil-based pens for best results and longevity!

TEXTURE & SHAPE

If the pumpkin is too bumpy it can make lettering really difficult. Try to find one that has a section that is smoother, or at least free of deep ridges/bumps, and make sure your pumpkin is clean before writing!

PLACEMENT & WORD COUNT

Depending on where you are putting the pumpkin, set it down and see how it rests so you know where your lettering will fit. If it's a really small pumpkin, consider just doing an initial. If it's a large pumpkin, write out your phrase a few times to scale and play around with the formatting!

PLURAL NAMES

Don't make a grammar mistake and put it on display for all to see! Make sure you have the correct pluralization for the name you're writing. *For most last names, simply add an s at the end. For last names that end in s, x, z, ch, or sh, add es to the end. Never an apostrophe!*

FAUX PUMPKINS

PERFECT for lettering, reusable, and make for timeless family heirlooms!
